



ServSafe® Food Safety Manager Training & Certification



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ServSafe certification is the official program of the National Restaurant Association, ANSI Accredited, recognized nationwide and valid for five years. Certification would fulfill the Food Law requirement that one manager per food establishment has completed a Food Safety Certificate Course.

This is a two-day training with the exam being administered on the second day (no makeup exams will be given). Pre-requisite for taking the exam: Examinees must have a valid picture ID. Examinees must obtain a score of 75% or higher to pass the exam and receive certification.

Who should attend?

Food service staff working at: restaurants, school cafeterias, nursing homes or public events where food is prepared and served. This includes managers, chefs, owners and others with supervisory responsibilities in the food industry.

Topics training will cover:

Personal hygiene, foodborne illness, receiving, storing, preparing and serving foods; food safety regulations and more.
