

**NCLEX pass rates:**

The National Council Licensing Examination also known as “NCLEX” is the licensing exam that the graduate takes to receive their license to practice as a Registered Nurse (RN) or Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN). St. Clair County Community College’s (SC4) nursing first time pass rate on the NCLEX for the ADN program is consistently above the state and national mean.
